

## Music Fest Policy

### **Purpose:**

This policy outlines the guidelines and expectations for attendees, performers, and staff during our music festival. Our goal is to create a safe, enjoyable, and inclusive environment for everyone involved.

### **Scope:**

This policy applies to all individuals attending or participating in the music festival, including ticket holders, artists, vendors, volunteers, and event staff.

### **General Guidelines:**

- All ticket sales are final. No refunds or exchanges allowed for any reason. Children three and under are free to admission.
- All venue participants' bags and personal items are subject to inspection before entering the event. Please review the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).
- Show respect to fellow attendees, artists, and staff. Any ticket holder who disrupts the enjoyment of the event will be asked to leave. Nudity, offensive gestures, or any other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.

### **Environment**

- The event will take place rain or shine. If severe weather becomes a threat and we need to interrupt the event, stage announcements will be made regarding safety procedures. Follow instructions from Festival staff. The event may resume when deemed safe.
- Show respect for the natural environment by disposing of trash properly and recycling.
- A designated area will be available for lost and found items at the Information Table.
- Firearms, tools/weapons of any type and laser pointers are strictly prohibited.
- Pets are not permitted at the event venue. However, service animals are welcome in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- Coolers containing food, drinks or alcohol are not permitted at the event.

### **Smoking/Alcohol**

- Waypoint's Music Fest is located on a smoke-free campus. Therefore, smoking of any kind is prohibited at the event or anywhere on the grounds.
- Attendees must be of legal drinking age to consume alcohol. Must show ID when entering. Excessive alcohol consumption or intoxication will not be tolerated.
- No illegal substances are allowed on the premises.

### **Performers**

- Performers must adhere to their scheduled performance times.

## Vendors

- Vendors must occupy assigned spaces.
- Vendors must comply with all health and safety regulations.

## Service Animals

- Waypoint allows ADA\* recognized service animals explicitly trained to assist people with disabilities. Animals whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the ADA and not permitted at the festival. If you have a certified service animal, you will be required to always have your service animal with you. Under the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices.

**\*Under the Americans with Disabilities Act, the definition of "service animal" is limited to a dog (or pony) that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability who is in attendance. The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person's disability. Under the ADA, "comfort," "therapy," or "emotional support animals" do not meet the definition of a service animal. – U.S. Dept. of Justice**

### What happened to the Waypoint Tele-Fest?

### Will there be food, drinks, or alcohol available?

- We will have two food trucks, Bubba Fries, Good Forking Grub, and other food vendors.
- Non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages will be for sale on the premises as well.

### Will my ticket get me into the Beer Garden?

- To enter the Beer Garden, you must have a ticket to the event and a valid photo ID for age verification.



### **How can I stay updated on event announcements and changes?**

- We recommend following our official social media channels and regularly checking our website to stay informed about event announcements and other important updates.

### **Can I bring my chair or seating to the event?**

- Absolutely! We kindly request that chairs be under 34" high. No recliners or footrests allowed. If your chair has a shade cover, it must be in the down position. We reserve the right to ask you to store your chair in your vehicle if it does not comply with the spirit of a low-profile chair.
